- Colombian Supremo Medium Roast (Fair Trade Organic)
  - Full body, rich flavour, and medium-high acidity; a perfect coffee at any time of the day.
- Colombian Supremo Decaf (Rain Forest Alliance)
  - Full body, rich flavour, and medium-high acidity.
  - Decaffeinated naturally using the Swiss Water ® process
- Tanzanian Peaberry Dark Roast
  - An unusually rich coffee with a lighter, winey acidity & medium body. From the slopes of Mt Kilimanjaro.
- Brazil Santos Medium dark Roast (Fair Trade Organic)
  - A blend of beans from several Brazilian regions, light bodied, low acid, with a mild & smooth finish.
- Sumatra Mandheling Dark Roast (Fair Trade Organic)
  - Earthy flavour/herbal aroma with low acidity. Flavours of roasted caramel & hints of bittersweet chocolate.
- Gaia Java Christmas Blend (all beans Fair Trade Organic)
  - Our special "gift of the magi" from the 3 Kings of coffee (Africa, Latin America and Indonesia). A rich and complex cup with subtle nuances of hazelnut and mocha. A jolly holiday blend! Great idea for a gift!!

We can provide the whole beans for you to grind yourself, or we can pre-grind them for e.g: drip filter or French Press (Bodum) brewing. (Specify with order)
